**Church Camp Theme 2010: Victory Through Faith!**

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

Let me begin by thanking you for signing up for our Church Camp to be held from the 10 - 13 June 2010 at *Equatorial Melaka Hotel*, Malacca, Malaysia. Kindly take note of the following:

1. We wish to inform you that we will **NOT** be conducting any camp briefing for all 352 campers (including children). Attached with this letter, we have prepared a briefing note so kindly take time to go through the list and familiarize yourself with what you need to bring, know and expect of the camp.
2. For those who have not given us your full particulars of your passport, kindly help us by furnishing the information as soon as possible. **Please also ensure that your passport is valid for at least six months on date of travel.**
3. We will all be **assembling at Church (AMKMC)** on the **10 June 2010 at 9.30 am** for a **short prayer** and we will be **departing at 10 am sharp.**
4. As for parking your cars at Church, please note that we **strongly discourage any parking of cars in Church** over the week.
5. For **parents with children** who will be attending the **Children's Program (P1-P4)** the following is the list of things to bring:-
  - a. Bible
  - b. Stationery – scissors, coloured pencils/ magic pen set, glue and writing materials
  - c. Sweater (in case the room is very cold).
6. There will be a celebration night on the last night of the camp and the theme for the evening will be **My Hero/Heroine** (including Biblical Heroes and Heroines. Your father or mother or fire-fighter can be your hero/ heroine. I shall leave it to your own imagination/ interpretation). We need your cooperation to dress up according to our Heroes/Heroines night theme. There will be a prize awarded to the best dressed Hero/Heroine outfits man and woman.
7. Bus co-ordinators, discussion leaders, worship leaders, prayer leaders, camp committee members etc... are working to ensure that the Camp runs as smoothly as

possible for all. Please encourage them with your co-operation, participation and be kind to them.

8. The estimated time of return to Singapore will be on Sunday at about 5 pm.

Once again, thank you for signing up for the camp. We pray that God will refresh and bless you richly as you participate in this camp.

## Briefing Notes for AMKMC Church Camp 2010

<b>Period of Church Camp:</b>	10- 13 June 2010
<b>Accommodation Venue of Camp:</b>	Equatorial Melaka Hotel
<b>Day of Departure:</b>	10 June 2010
<b>Place of Assembly &amp; Registration:</b>	Ang Mo Kio Methodist Church – Church Sanctuary
<b>Time:</b>	9.30 am
<b>Departure:</b>	10 am sharp

### Please take note of the following:

1. All participants are reminded that they are to participate in **ALL** activities at the Church Camp. Exemptions will only be given to those who are sick or any emergency situations. (Be warned: We are aware the World Cup is on and you may want to watch the soccer match instead of attending the camp session but I want to warn you that God is watching too! No pun intended. And certainly watching a soccer match is not an emergency case.)
2. A camp file will be given to you on the day of departure which will include the program Schedule, hotel facilities, camp officials, bus groupings, discussion groupings, teaching outlines, etc...
3. All campers will be issued with a lanyard name tag on the day of departure and it is to be worn at all times for the purpose of identification, bus travel, meals and all organized activities. At the end of the camp, the lanyard name tag is to be returned.
4. Kindly remember to bring your **own regular medication** if you are under any kind of medication and do inform the Camp Commandant or the Camp Medical Doctor if we need to take note of any medical condition in case of emergency.
5. The total bus journey from Singapore to Malacca will be about 4 hours so please dress comfortably for the journey. It will be advisable to don on warm clothing or have a pair of jackets/sweater at hand during the bus journey as the buses are fully air-conditioned and it can be cold. The buses have no toilets but should you require to ease yourself, request can be made for the bus to stop along the way.
6. You have been assigned to different buses for travel. Please follow the instructions of your assigned Bus coordinators.
7. Things to bring:
  - a. Bible
  - b. Pen/Pencils
  - c. A jacket or a pair of warm clothing in case the meeting halls are too cold.
  - d. Sufficient clothing for the entire duration of the camp including swim wear for those who want to swim in the Hotel pool.
  - e. Appropriate costumes/ clothes for the My Hero/ Heroine dress code.
  - f. Sufficient Malaysian ringgits for your personal shopping, 2 lunches enroute (10 & 13 June) and 1 dinner in Malacca (11 June) on your own.

8. There will be a celebration night on the last night of the camp. The theme for the celebration night will be **“My Hero/Heroine.”** Kindly come prepared for the evening and make some effort to dress for the Celebration Night. There will be an award given to the best dressed Hero/Heroine outfits Man and Woman.
9. **For those who have babies**, kindly ensure that your baby’s passport photo is updated to avoid being turned away at the customs.
10. **For those with domestic helpers**, kindly ensure that they bring along their passport as well as their work permit card (original).
11. **For Non-Singaporeans**, kindly ensure that you have appropriate visa permit to travel into Malaysia.
12. **For those who are driving** to Malacca, you may proceed straight to Malacca without coming to AMKMC but please be there between **1.30 pm to 3.30 pm** to collect your room keys and files from **Mr Calvin Lim at Melaka Ballroom 1 (Level 2)** and be there for the compulsory **Campers’ Briefing/ photo taking at 4.30 pm**.
13. For your information we have an official photographer for the camp.
14. The estimated time of return to Singapore on the 13 June 2010 is about 5 pm.
