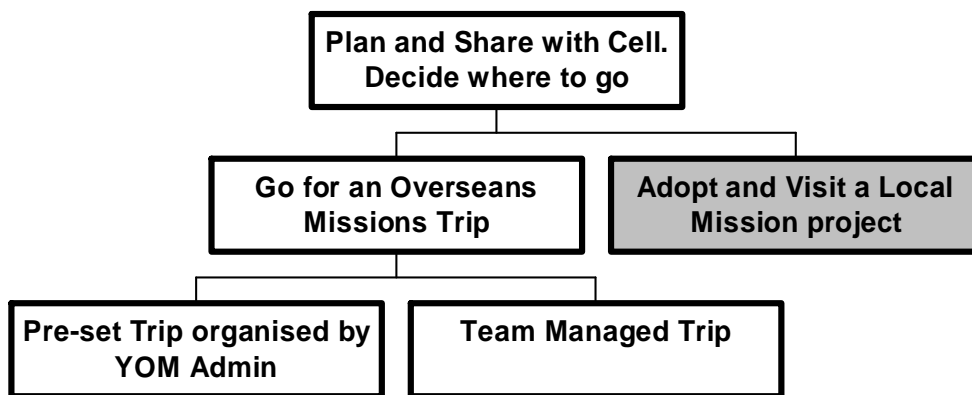


**AMKMC 2011 Year of Mission
Addendum to 'AMKMC Mission Guide' -
"What do to if you want to visit a LOCAL mission project?"**

In AMKMC's Year of Mission, the cell can choose to:

- i. Make a trip to a mission field project, exposure or ministry.
[recommended]
- ii. Adopt and visit a local mission project.

This is the Action Plan Overview:



This addendum will detail what you need to do if you 'Adopt and Visit a Local Mission Project' (option ii).

What Does the Cell Leader Need to Do to Adopt and Visit a Local Mission Project?

1. Have a plan.

Know what the cell can do before you start to share with your cell. **Do make sure your means match your mission** - *Meaning make sure your cell or team has the gifting to minister, and there is no need to seek financial assistance from elsewhere.*

2. Read the AMKMC Mission Guide & the 'How to Go for a Trip (Local Mission Project)?' segment.

Most of the information detailed here are repeated from the AMKMC Mission Guide. A list of local mission fields is provided at the end of this document.

3. Decide which local mission project your cell will adopt/visit.

Once the cell has decided which ministry they will go, do inform the Zone Leader and the 'Year of Missions Admin (YOM Admin)'. This step is necessary for confirmation and communication, especially with the host (local mission project leader).

4. The YOM Admin will provide the team with a simple framework and necessary information for the team/cell leader to embark on the trip.

The YOM Admin will provide assistance to make the first contact with local mission project leader. Please cooperate with the YOM Admin and be supportive as much as possible for there will be many factors and issues to consider in the running of this church-wide project.

5. Appoint a team leader from the cell to lead the team. Hold team meetings to prepare for the trip.

After the YOM Admin has linked you up with the local mission project leader, the team leader will take over to discuss the dates that you will visit, and what you can do.

You are strongly encouraged to make at least two visits for your adopted Local Mission Field. First visit is to observe, learn and pray. Second visit your cell will minister to the people – share your testimony, lead worship, sponsor the meals for the outreach, etc. – to be discussed with the local mission project leader *.

**After the visit, pray and discuss with cell what you will do for the next visit. Contact the local mission project leader and discuss the ideas. Once the ministry leader agrees, inform YOM Admin your second visit and what you will do.*

6. Submit a simple report with photos and testimonies*.

After the trip, the team/cell will be required to write a simple report and enclose up to 4 photos of the local mission project that you had visited. The YOM Admin will provide the format for the report. Please submit the report to the YOM Admin via ***yom.amkmc@gmail.com*** .

***Note:** *that your report and photos may be edited and used as testimonies to be shared at appropriate settings, or be published in appropriate church publications (eg newsletter, website).*

7. Make it fun, enjoyable and a precious learning experience for the whole cell.

**HOW TO GO FOR A TRIP (LOCAL MISSION PROJECT)
A FLOW CHART TO GUIDE YOU**

<p>FACT FINDING</p>	<p>A) The cell engages YOM Admin on local mission project of interest. B) Cell leader discuss on requirements. (eg. Date; no. of people). C) All cell members are OK with cost and requirements of trip. D) Appoints a team leader for the trip.</p>
<p>DECIDE ON A MISSION TRIP</p>	<p>A) The cell decides which local mission project to adopt/visit. B) YOM admin will link cell group up with the local mission project leader.</p>
<p>APPLY TO YOM ADMIN</p>	<p>A) Cell leader to apply officially to YOM admin by submitting the YOM 2011 FORM. B) All submissions to be via yom.amkmc@gmail.com C) YOM admin will send the team leader an admin package to help the cell plan and execute the mission project.</p>
<p>PRE-TRIP PREPARATIONS</p>	<p>A) Team Leader calls for briefing. B) Team Leader to hold regular meetings with team to firm up program, list out responsibilities/roles, run-through check-list. C) Team to submit to YOM Admin prayer requests to Prayer Ministry.</p>
<p>MISSION TRIP PROPER</p>	<p>A) You are strongly encouraged to make TWO visits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First visit is to observe, learn and pray. • Second visit your cell will minister to the people – share your testimony, lead worship, sponsor the meals for the outreach, etc. – to be discussed with the local mission project leader. <p>B) Keep a journal of your visit and document your thoughts individually. C) Evaluate as a team after each visit. Compile sharings into trip report. D) Team to be prayerful throughout the visit & enjoy the trip.</p>
<p>POST-TRIP ADMIN</p>	<p>A) Team to submit the following to YOM Admin: - Visit Report (aka 'Trip Report') with up to 4 photos within 1 month. - Videos (if any) to be submitted to Church Office (Attn to: Rev Leslie Lim) in a DVD format. B) To keep it safe & simple – strictly NO BLOGGING (inc FACEBOOK) on the place/people you have visited.</p>

2. Although these are local mission projects, all processes for registration and communications is as detailed in the AMKMC Mission Guide.
