

Pastoral Letter to the Ang Mo Kio Methodist Church Family (11 June 2021)

Dear Family and Friends of AMKMC (TRAC),

I trust that you have been taking the appropriate measures to safeguard yourself and your loved ones in the last few weeks, and I am thankful to our Loving Father for His mercy and protection on us all so far.

Despite being unable to meet most of you face-to-face during the past few weeks, it warms my heart to know that so many of you miss coming to worship in Church, and that you are eagerly waiting for on-site worship services to re-open.

Well, as many of you know by now, the ministry taskforce for COVID-19 recently announced that the current tightened measures will be eased progressively from 14 June. This is indeed good news - Praise the Lord!

However, while we have been given the green light to resume regular on-site worship services for 250 pax with pre-event testing (PET) and 50 pax without PET, we have decided to continue with only the **online worship service for 20 and 27 June 2021**. Due to the amount of preparation that is required to re-open, including further consultation with MCCY, we seek your continued patience and understanding in allowing us more time to do so.

Nevertheless, please be reassured that we are prayerfully considering and making plans for the **resumption of on-site worship services from 4 July onwards**. We also look forward to resuming AMKids on-site.
